

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSBY

BY-LAW NO. 76-38

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF GUNS OR OTHER FIREARMS,
AIR-GUNS AND SPRING GUNS OR ANY CLASS OR TYPE THEREOF.

Whereas Section 354 (1) (30) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, empowers the Councils of local municipalities to pass by-laws for prohibiting or regulating the discharge of guns, or other firearms, air-guns or any class or type thereof in the Municipality;



And whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby deems it desirable to prohibit the discharge of such guns and firearms within the Town of Grimsby.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby enacts as follows:

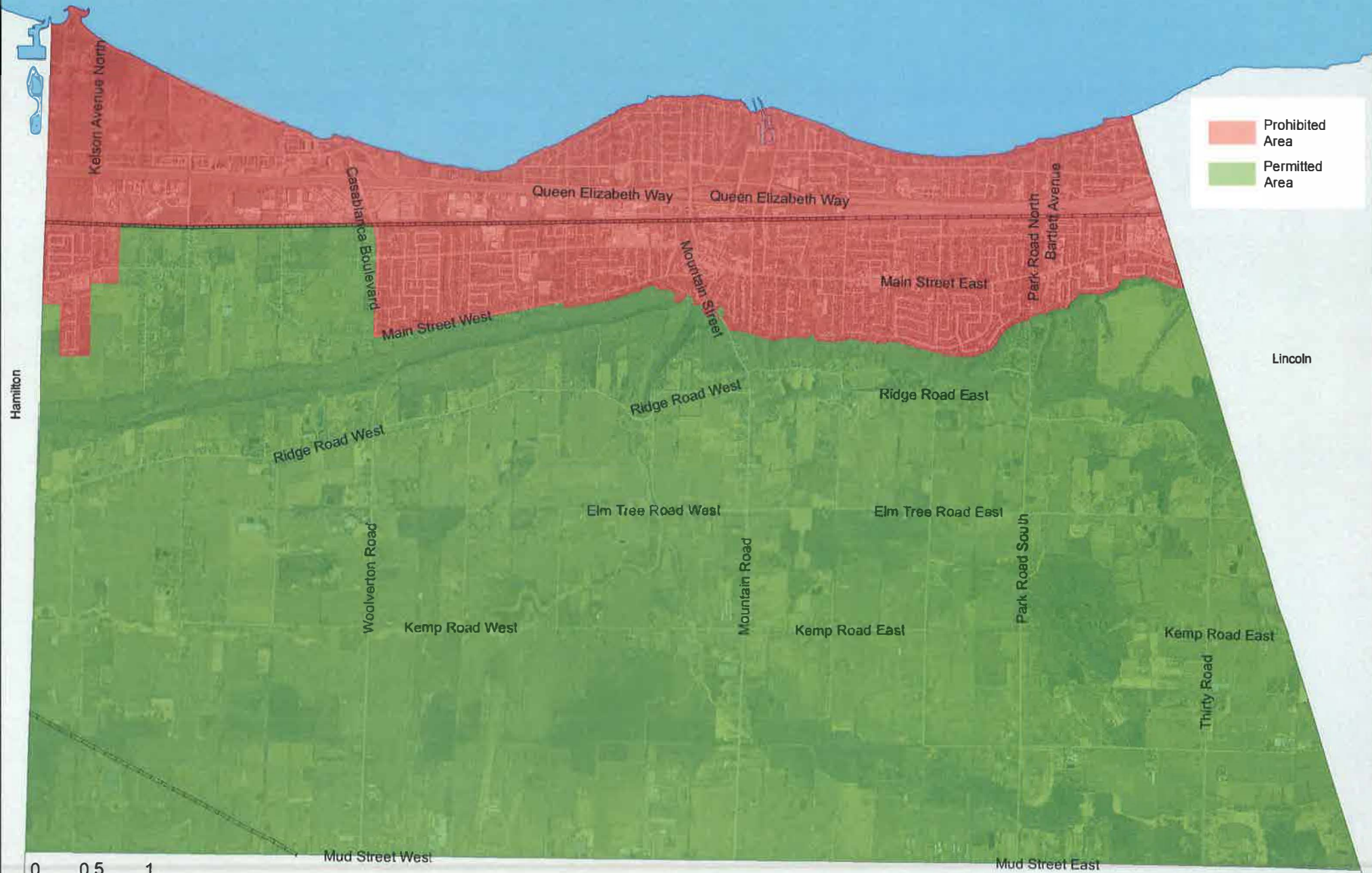
1. That no person other than a Police Officer in the lawful discharge of his duties, shall discharge a gun, or other firearm, an air-gun or spring gun, or any class or type thereof, within the town of Grimsby.
- 1.1 No person shall discharge a firearm or bow in a prohibited area of the Town as outlined in Schedule "A" to this By-law.
2. That this By-law shall not apply:
 - a) to the destruction of a farm or domestic animal for humane reasons, or to the destruction, by the owner, his agent or servant on the owner's property, of rodents, rabbits and pestiferous birds or animals provided that the type of gun used is a shot gun using shot no larger than #2 gauge and that the shot gun is not discharged within 150 yards of any building, and further provided that an agent or servant of an owner that has the owner's consent in writing.
 - b) to the discharge of firearms for the purpose of target or skeet and trap shooting, carried on under the supervision of organized gun and revolver clubs, on ranges properly equipped for such purposes.
 - c) for the purpose of this By-law, pheasants, geese, ducks and other game birds shall not be considered pestiferous birds.
 - d) owner for the purpose of this By-law shall include any person who is the owner of an interest in the land entitling him to possession of it and shall include a tenant farmer.
3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of \$300.00 for each offence.
4. By-law No. 70-42 is hereby repealed.
5. That this By-law shall come into force on the day it is passed by Council of the Corporation of the Town of Grimsby.

Read a first time this 3 day of May, 1976.

Read a second and third time and finally passed this 3 day of May, 1976.

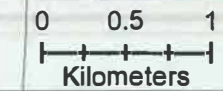
